Quarry Crag OS Ref: NY 245001



Grades

The natural outcrop above a disused quarry that is marked on the 1:25000 OS map. Height ~18m.

Approach

Park at SD 237 996, space for 2-3 vehicles at a triangular widening and forest access gate 200m up the valley from the Forestry Commission car park. Walk along the track till it fades out at a clearing / turning head, then head uphill for 50m to a stile over the forest fence. A good path runs along the fellside above the stone wall. Follow this northwards for a few hundred metres to the old quarry workings, the natural crag lies just above.
