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You climb at your own risk. Climbing is a dangerous activity carrying the risk of serious injury or death. If you climb, the presumption is that you are aware of and accept these risks together with responsibility for your activities and your safety.

You are the sole judge of conditions, the suitability of any chosen route, the ability of the party and you take sole responsibility for your actions.

Rock is a dynamic medium and rockfalls are frequent. In the mountains the weather changes quickly, climbs change unpredictably; blocks, flakes and holds become loose and fall off, rock becomes vegetated and dirty, in situ gear deteriorates or disappears. Even a minor change can have a dramatic effect on the difficulty or seriousness of a route. There can be no presumption that any given climb will be found in the condition described. It is therefore essential that climbers judge the seriousness or difficulty of any route before committing themselves.


The name gives a clue as to the character of the crag - this is a super pleasant spot located to the west of the Seathwaite Tarn track.

There has been considerable development at this pleasant area since the publication of Duddon & Wrynose (2021). This mini-guide updates th details given in that book.

Approach

Park at the bottom of the Walna Scar Road and walk 500m up the Seathwaite Tarn track. On the left is a lone scots pine and on its right is a hurdle closing a gap in the wall. Go through the gap and the crag can be seen 200m to the north. Alternatively, the crag can be reached from the High Close enclosure by a short walk to the east.

Approach time is 15-20 minutes, however it may be stretched to a somewhat insouciant saunter of 30 minutes.



Ra Ridge M 120m


Sullity Fike Kluge

Climb the ridge which is mostly grade 2 scrambling. A rope is recommended for the tricky section following a ramp up rightwards with an awkward move to get established on a ledge (gear). Then climb up directly on good holds.



Sunny Pike LHS routes 1-6



The groove just left of *Rayon de Soleil* gives a well-protected bridging exercise. 16.10.2022 R Graham, T Rogers



Just left of *Glenr* is a clean steep slab and arête, blank save for one good hold on the arête at the half-height diagonal break. Ascend just left of the water streak. There is reasonable protection left of the arête when you gain the good hold, however it might not be high enough to save you from a ground-fall from the crux above.

3 Glenr Super Direct HVS 5b 15m

Start between Rayon de Soleil and Glenr then gain and climb the thin cracks..

Glenr HS 4b 20m

At the lower left end of the crag lies a steep slab with a ramp to its right. Climb the slab moving right onto the ramp which gives access to a ledge above topped by a large block. Gain the ledge and block then step left up to a second ledge leading to the top.

Huggin S 4a 20m

Start one metre right of <u>Glenr</u>, climb the slab direct to the crack between the blocks and finish up the short walls above.



Start one metre right of <u>Huggin</u> and climb to the right side of the block moving left round the top of this to join <u>Huggin</u>.

Sunny Pike LHS route 7-10



Vildsvin VS 4b † New 20m

To the right of *Huggin* the base of the crag rises a couple of metres. At the left edge of this rise are some flat stones marking the start of *Vildsvin*. Climb a series of small ledges to the right end of a left-slanting ramp giving access to a slab topped by a roof. Step right onto the slab to gain a slanting crack and some jugs, continue directly to the top.

Start 2m right of *Vildsvin* and follow a line of slanting holds to a small pillar. Climb the block/pillar to make an awkward and committing high step onto a ledge,follow holds to the left to gain the top.


Start 2m right of *Varg* below a short left-facing corner. Climb the corner and then make awkward moves to exit right onto a ledge, step left to finish.

Start 2m right of *Bjorn* at the convergence of two slanting cracks. Climb the steep slab on slanting holds to gain a ledge, then gain the next ledge and finish pleasantly ascending to the right.

Sunny Outlook VS 4c 🛉 New 25m

Climb the bold slab, about 2m left of *Sunny Jim* to reach the grass ledge. Continue up a short grove and crack to the left edge of the sloping shelf of *Sunny Jim*. Finish pleasantly up and left. A spotter (singing I Got you Babe?) may make the initial slab feel more comfortable.

12 Sunny Jim VS 4c 25m

Climb the slab confidently to reach a grass ledge. Continue to a shallow corner and sloping shelf. Once established move up and left then back rightwards to finish. Poor belays.

Sunni Wall S 25m

Climb up to a grass platform, then move slightly right to follow steep flake holds directly to the top. 16 Feb 2019 A Phizacklea, JL Holden



To the right of *Sunni Wall* is a hanging pod. This route starts at the base of a shallow corner some 10m left of the pod. Climb the shallow corner to a mossy slab which is traversed up to the right to the base of a steep wall. Use a high jug to reach a higher jug which allows progress to be made to the left side of a small roof, continue directly above to finish.

Start slightly to the right of the hanging pod at a series of ramps trending up to the left. Follow the ramps to the left arête of the pod and climb it on spaced jugs to finish.

Akrals VD † New 15m

The hanging pod between *Arvakr* and *Alsvior*. Climbing the easiest way to the ledge then up the groove between the two VS's is about V Diff. Don't miss a Walnut 5 placement in the mucky bed of the groove. No cleaning required , must have been done earlier in the year to miss out on the tricky VS moves either side.

Start 1m to the right of *Arvakr* and climb directly to a large block. Surmount the block to continue up the steep obtuse corner on spaced jugs to the top.

Aska VD 🕇 New 25m

The diagonal line starting to the right of Alsvior and finishing to the right of Sunni Wall.

The steep line to the right of *Alsvior*. Start below the waist high shallow niche, climb into it and directly up past a break. Make thin moves up the ochre coloured rock to a flake. Use holds on the left on the grey rock and a long reach gains the left slanting crack to finish.

Avsugning VD 30m

A joyous romp across this part of the crag, climbed during high winds. The obvious right to left rising line starting from the foot of *Lipsill* to finish to the left of *Sol*.

Lipsill E1 5a † New 25m

The obvious steep broken crack line to the right of *Svalinn*. Start just to the right of a shallow niche at knee height and follow the left wall of the crack to good finishing holds.

Starts below the hanging corner 1.5m to the left of the crack of *Skoll*. Climb to the hanging corner, at its top step left to finish.

Skoll HVS 5a † New 25m

Take the crack and flakes to the left of *Sunny Boy*. Difficult moves at the small roof gain a narrow ledge where flakes lead to the top.

13.11.2021 P C Bennett, D Baker Skoll is name for mockery.



Sunny Boy HVS 5a 20m

Originally climbed the wall leftwards to the base of a flake but now normally follow the lower crack, as for <u>Skoll</u>. Steep moves above lead to the top. An easy second pitch is available above if you want !! [D].

Fizzle S4a 20m

The line of big holds. 12.07.2020 RO Graham, E Rogers



Hati VS 4c 25m

Starting 2m to the right of *Fizzle* to follow jugs/flakes up and left, crossing *Fizzle* just below its block, then follow a line of flakes trending leftwards to the top.





Introduction

This fine diminutive slab of excellent rock lies below the Main Crag - Upper Buttress.





Kharkiv D New 7m

Start 1m right of the vegetated chimney. Reach for high flake holds and gain a ledge, then then follow the right trending line right of the arête.

Mariupol VD New 7m

Start below a thin hanging crack at mid-height 2m right of *Kharkiv*. Climb up to the right of the crack and follow the slab above.

The obvious right ascending ramp line starting just left of the foot of Zaporizhzhia.
