



## Duddon Valley - Lower Duddon

### Cinder Hill Crag (SD 202 921)

This eGuide updates the earlier edition with the inclusion of routes added in 2025 and 2026.

A series of small buttresses which complement the nearby Ribcage, Fox and Yew Barrow Crag. See Duddon & Wrynose (2021) page 42 onwards for details of these crags.

**Approach:** Approach from parking in the disused quarry at 54.317409 -3.233677 / SD 199 920



### Main Slab

#### 1 Cinder 8m Severe

The slab on the left, may be the same as the next route.

#### 2 Serendipity 9m Severe

Climb the left side of the slab. May be the same as *Cinder*?

#### 3 Honeycomb 9m Severe

Left side of the main slab.

#### 4 Happenstance 10m Severe

Climb the centre of the slab via an obvious rightward trending groove.

#### 5 Bonne Chance 9m HVS 4c

Climb the steep wall about 2m left of the deep chimney below the holly tree.

#### 6 Holly crack 9m VDiff

The obvious crack.

Short and sharp.

### 1 Heather Wall 15m MVS

Left side of the crag finishing in some heather.

### 2 Cinderella 29m E1 5b

Wall and dark coloured overlaps finishing up a rib.

### 3 Swingover 18m HVS 5a

Cracked groove finishing with a swing to the left to join the final part of *Cinderella*.

### 4 Bit Short. Bit Loose. Bit Grim. Bit Pointless 20m VS

Now cleaner and much easier. Nice little nose, after the hold move up right to a pleasant finish.

The wall to the right moving left to join Bit Short ...

## Nice Little Nose

### Nice Little Nose 8m HVS 5a

A short little nose with a sapling at its foot. Approach from the right hand side, grab a prominent hold on the arête and you're done.

## Oak Tree Wall



1 Left Hand 10m HS      2 Centre 10m HS      3 Right-Hand Route 11m VS 4b

### 1 Left Hand 10m HS

The left side of the wall starting up a thin crack and passing to the right of a niche.

### 2 Centre 10m HS

The short arête and wall above finishing over a small overhang.
